			Discussion regarding U15 – team 3. Not enough players to roster a team. No decisions made.
5	Ice Scheduling / Referees	Evan McFadden / Lee Charlton	Watford Removed 1.5 hrs from Monday ice time and replaced with a late Saturday ice time. Glencoe Allocated our 24/25 ice time to men's team. Offered additional prime Sunday ice to Vision (for profit hockey organization) Currently have nothing in Glencoe. Petrolia Sunday night ice was moved to later time. Potential issues for home games due to WOGHL rules on when visiting team must be home. Discussions with Petrolia are ongoing regarding these concerns. Alvinston No update Open ice is available early mornings. May need to consider this time to meet our ice needs. Briefly discussed ongoing human rights complaint from Kenora. Filed in 2024 and currently before the courts. Case around not equitable allocation of ice time for male/female hockey which represents a code violation as it is discriminatory based on sex. Discussed next steps. Decided the Board would send a strongly worded letter pleading for ice time. Discuss the unfair allocation of ice, the potential negative impact to young females and informing of the active human rights case. Letters to go to Petrolia, Warwick and Glencoe Councils, CAO and Director of Parks/Rec as well as the local MPP, MP.

7	Equipment / Personal Requirements	Justin Free	Jersey's U15 Tier 1 jerseys have not been returned yet. Justin in contact to try and obtain these jerseys. U18 Tier 2 jerseys are in bad shape. Obtained 3 quotes for new team jerseys: Pro Hockey 69-83 + 10% kickback Herms \$65 for our style; 60 if we go to the scoop neck Team Outfitter - \$85-90 per jersey Will proceed with purchasing U11 jerseys as these are required due to third team. All other potential purchases are put on hold currently. Discussion regarding potentially switching to same model as other centers where jersey's are purchased by players rather than provided by the association. If this change is made it would not happen for the 25/26 season. Discussed potential cost to players. For Sarnia the cost to the player for a set of 2 jersey's is \$120 Discussed benefits and concerns over this switch. Will investigate where Sarnia buys their jersey's from.
			 Name Bars Discussed challenges with jersey's not being returned in a timely manner as a result of name bars being added. Discussed potential options to avoid delays such as: 'bond' that will be returned if jerseys are returned Additional fee added to players registration amount Loss of team ice time at beginning of next season Discussed allowing name bars for 25/26 season. Decision to allow name bars but board to revisit the process/requirements to try and mitigate concerns with delay in jerseys being returns.

			 Follow up from last meeting Tiffany has found and experienced/skilled sewer that is offering to add/remove bars from jersey's free of charge. She would not be able to accommodate large volumes in a short time but if we staggered to drop offs every couple of weeks she can accommodated. Board approved this scenario. Tiffany is currently waiting on response from a church group to assist as well.
			 Socks We have lots of socks in the locker that we will try and use up for the 25/26 season. Price to purchase – current style is \$25 per pair; a standard sock is \$21 per pair. If we switch to standard sock, will we be able to use the excess socks in the lockers? Follow Up

Explore highschool students, players siblings, rotate parents/volunteers, etc. Discuss at some point the volunteer credit structure and new jobs needs to be revamped Discussed adding a parent rep to each team. This rep would be responsible for sending team pictures/updates so social media posts can be made.
